

Active Projects:

1. Hickory Street turnback
 - Project has been awarded to Morgan Excavating.
 - **HCEG has been coordinating with utility companies. Next step will be executing a relocation cost share agreement.**
2. Act 537 Wastewater Management Plan
 - **Draft flow projections have been shared with WEWJA for their comprehensive plan.**
3. SR 844 Sanitary Sewer I&I Project
 - **WEWJA is investigating the next phase of I&I project. WEWJA will install cast in place liner anywhere the Township pays for cleaning and grouting.**
4. MS4 Permit
 - Updated & Advertised PRP Plan has been submitted to DEP. No comments have been received yet.
 - 5 Year Renewal has been submitted and received by DEP. DEP stated their technical review may take up to 12 months.
 - **Annual report has been prepared and submitted.**
5. MS4 Stream Restoration – Logpile Run / Weirich Avenue
 - **Need to prioritize determining new project location. Growing Greener grant to expire December 2023.**
6. West Wylie Park
 - Harshman prepared and submitted a grant to DCED's GTRP grant for Phase 1 Park Development. Decision expected in fall 2023.
 - **HCEG is preparing application for the Statewide LSA Grant.**
7. Running Brooke
 - Building Permit approved and awaiting payment & pick-up by Permittee.
