Active Projects:

1. The Circle Runoff Complaint
 - HCEG to prepare inspection report regarding runoff for DEP.
2. PRD Development
 - HCEG coordinating application needs with Applicant.
3. Canton Township Park
 - Fencing plan has been prepared and sent out for quotes
4. Hickory Street turnback
 - Project has been awarded to Morgan Excavating.
 - Project to begin spring 2024
5. MS4 Stream Restoration – Logpile Run / Weirich Avenue
 - Need to prioritize determining new project location. Growing Greener grant to expire December 2023.
6. MS4 Permit
 - Updated & Advertised PRP Plan has been submitted to DEP. Comments have been received from DEP and we're preparing responses.
 - 5 Year Renewal has been submitted and received by DEP. DEP stated their technical review may take up to 12 months.
7. West Wylie Park
 - Harshman prepared and submitted a grant to DCED's GTRP grant for Phase 1 Park Development. Decision expected in fall 2023.
 - Statewide LSA Grant has been prepared and submitted.
8. Act 537 Wastewater Management Plan
 - Draft flow projections have been shared with WEWJA for their comprehensive plan.
9. SR 844 Sanitary Sewer I&I Project
 - WEWJA is investigating the next phase of I&I project. WEWJA will install cast in place liner anywhere the Township pays for cleaning and grouting.
10. Running Brooke
 - Building Permit approved and awaiting payment & pick-up by Permittee.

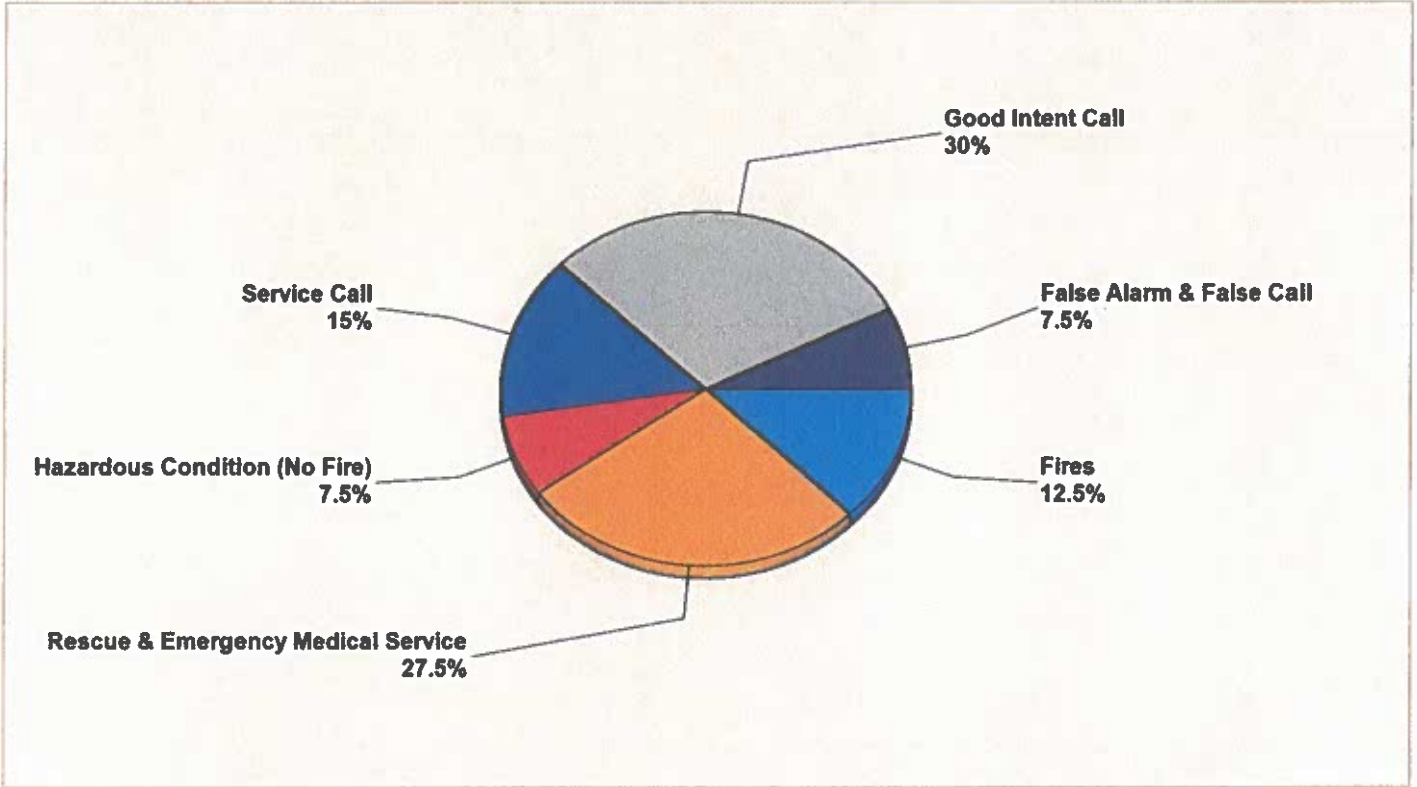
