

Township Engineer's Report March 14th 2024

Active Projects

1. SR 844 Sanitary Sewer I&I Project
 - Met with WEWJA 3/13. WEWJA will install cast in place liner anywhere the Township pays for cleaning and grouting. WEJWA is determining the best location for the work.
2. Hickory Street turnback
 - CCTV inspection of the existing lines has begun.
3. PRD Development
 - HCEG is awaiting land development submission.
4. MS4 Stream Restoration – Logpile Run / Weirich Avenue
 - HCEG has begun preparing base maps for new proposed property. HCEG will be ready to meet with Landowner by the last week in March.
5. West Wylie Park
 - HCEG will prepare and submitted a grant to DCED's GTRP and the Broadband Authority's Multipurpose Community Facilities Grant for Phase 1 Park Development.
 - Statewide LSA Grant has been prepared and submitted.
6. Canton Township Park
 - HCEG is coordinating contracting and scheduling with Morelli Fence for their quoted price of \$13,750.
7. GIS Services
 - iPad Setup complete with base mapping and forms.
 - HCEG will be digitizing other Township maps to include in the GIS database.
8. MS4 Permit
 - DEP has approved the 5 year permit renewal and Pollutant Reduction Plan.
9. Act 537 Wastewater Management Plan
 - Draft flow projections have been shared with WEWJA for their comprehensive plan.
10. Running Brooke
 - Applicant has yet to pick up building permit or pay review fees.

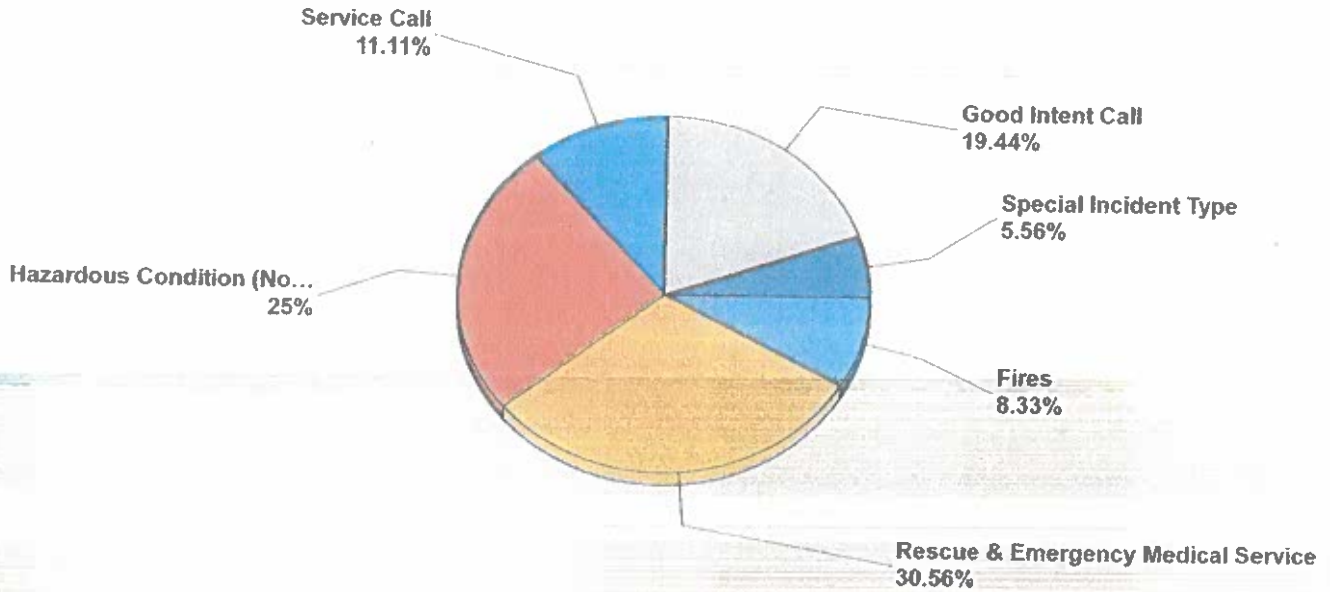
