Active Projects

1. Washington Penn Plastics Grading Permit
 - HCEG has reviewed the application and is coordinated additional information with the applicant.
2. Brickidge Estates Phase IV
 - HCEG has reviewed preliminary subdivision submission and prepared a comment response letter.
3. Hickory Street turnback
 - Construction is underway. Updates to the project are prepared for TWP Review/Approval.
4. MS4 Stream Restoration – Logpile Run / Weirich Avenue
 - HCEG has prepared base mapping and is coordinating a meeting with the land owner to discussion the project.
5. West Wylie Park
 - HCEG prepared design plans and estimates for the Rec Center Project and will submit for the Broadband Authority's Multipurpose Community Facilities Grant by April 19th.
6. Canton Township Park
 - Original contractor has been non-responsive and not executed the contracts.
 - HCEG will prepare formal bid docs to publicly bid the fencing project.
7. Malone Ridge Stormwater
 - HCEG has prepared bid plans, met with landowner, and solicited bids from contractors
 - 4 Quotes were received
 - JStewart Excavating LLC \$16,730.00
 - Strnisha Excavation Inc \$19,924.00
 - Slusarczyk Excavating \$23,100.00
 - Hogen's Heroes Inc \$39,245.00
8. SR 844 Sanitary Sewer I&I Project
 - Met with WEWJA 3/13. WEWJA will install cast in place liner anywhere the Township pays for cleaning and grouting. WEJWA is determining the best location for the work.
9. GIS Services
 - HCEG will be digitizing other Township maps to include in the GIS database.
10. MS4 Permit
 - DEP has approved the 5 year permit renewal and Pollutant Reduction Plan.
11. Act 537 Wastewater Management Plan
 - Draft flow projections have been shared with WEWJA for their comprehensive plan.
12. Running Brooke
 - Applicant has yet to pick up building permit or pay review fees.

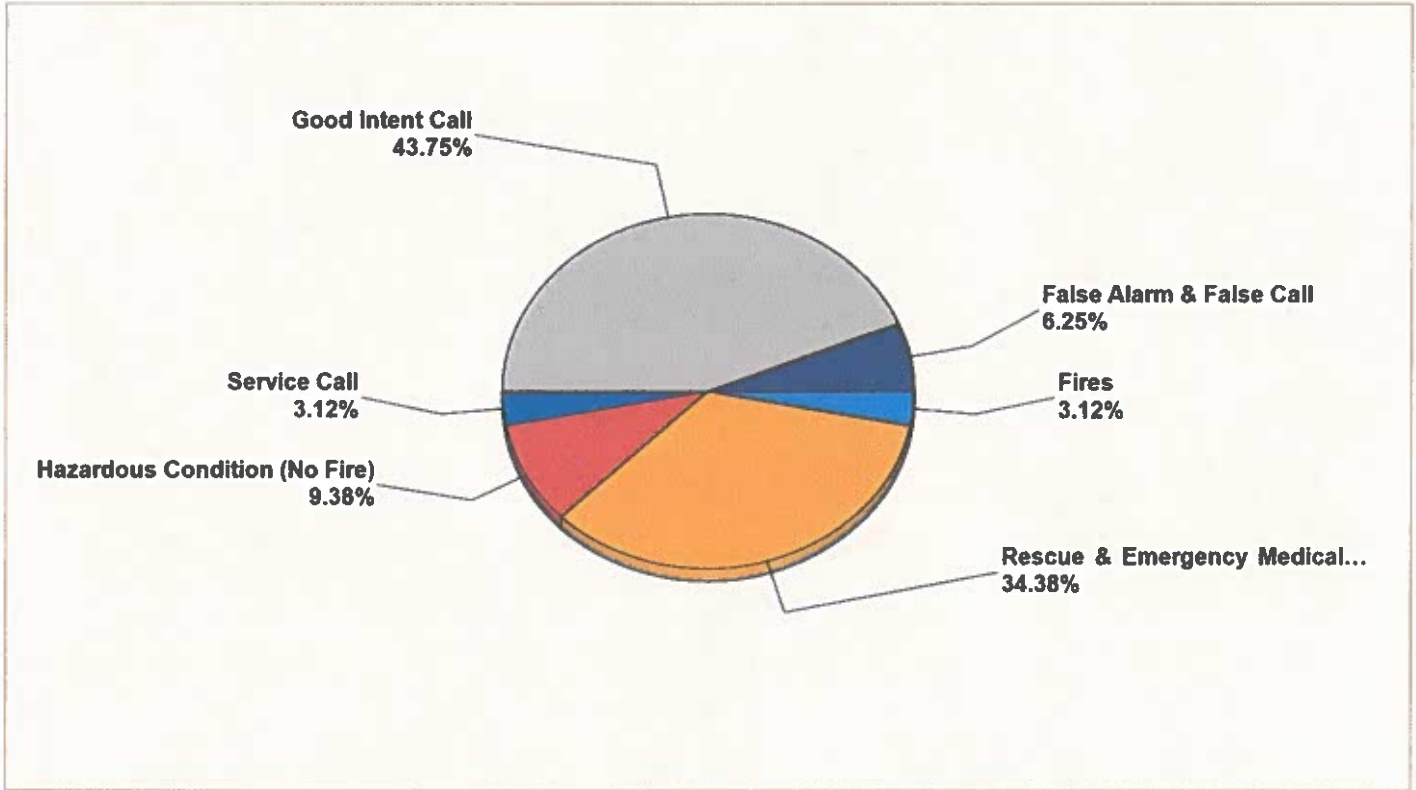
