

1. Canton Township Park
 - Bid awarded to Allstate Fence for the amount of \$30,600.00
 - HCEG is coordinating contracting with All State Fence
2. Hickory Street turnback
 - Sidewalk work will commence this week
 - HCEG has reviewed Pay Application #2
3. Malone Ridge Stormwater
 - HCEG is preparing an easement exhibit for the new stormsewer line
 - HCEG met with adjacent property owner to review drainage complaints
4. MS4 Permit
 - Annual reports are due in September
5. Running Brooke
 - Applicant has paid the building permit review fees and picked up their building permit.
6. The Dales at Canton PRD
 - Land development submission received 7/5/2024
 - HCEG has completed a completeness review and sent findings to the applicant.
7. Brickridge Estates Phase IV
 - Preliminary subdivision approval was conditionally approved

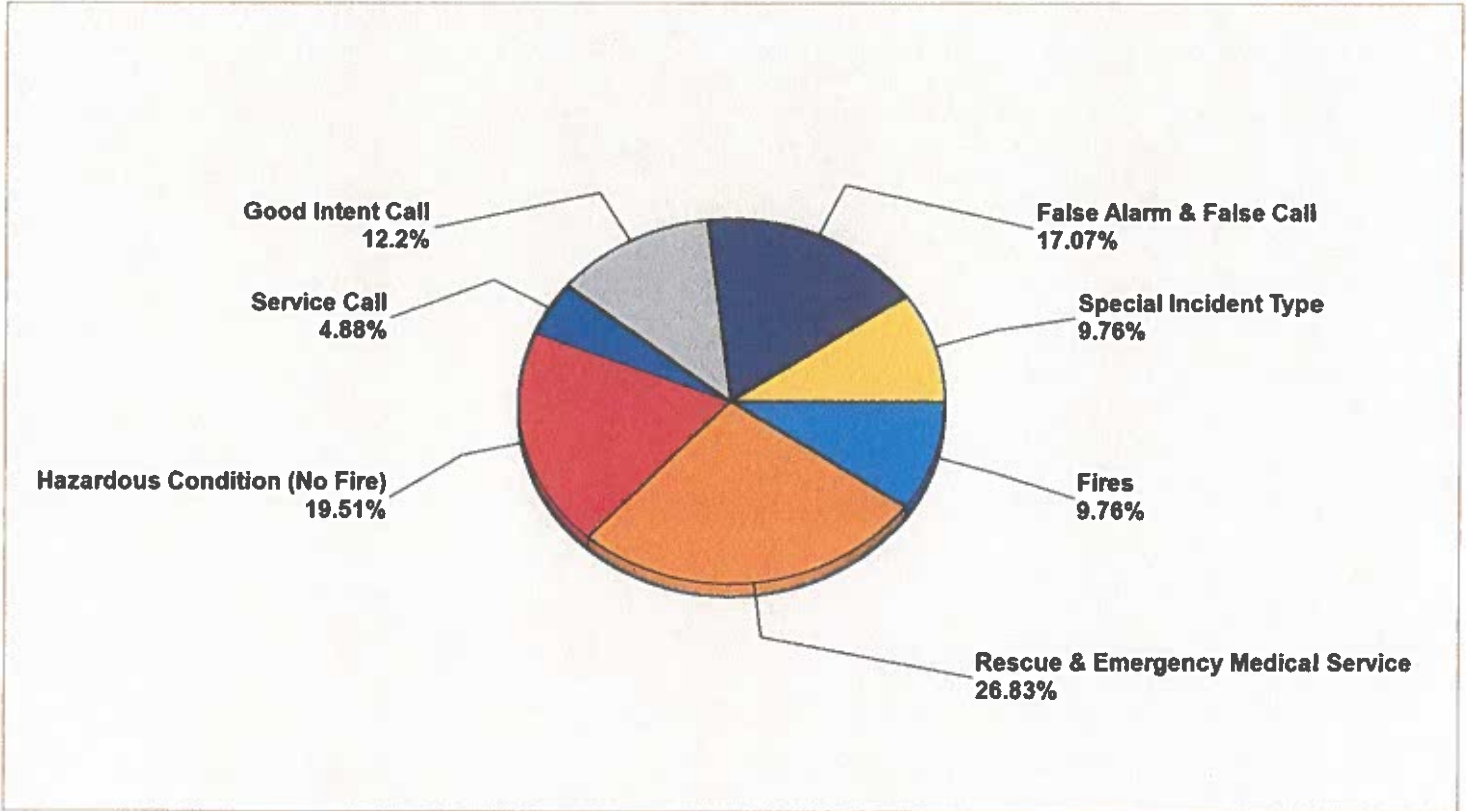
