

Township Engineer's Report November 14th, 2024

Active Projects

1. Subdivision Reviews
 - HCEG has reviewed the 2024 Starr Subdivision.
 - HCEG has reviewed the Kopko No. 1 Subdivision
2. Canton Township Park
 - Bid awarded to All State Fence for the amount of \$30,600.00
 - Contractor has installed the fence and is waiting for delivery of the privacy slats and gates.
3. Miller Road Improvements Project
 - HCEG is preparing GP-7 Permit for replacing the culverts
 - HCEG has prepared cost estimates and is preparing grant applications to help fund the project.
 - HCEG prepared grant applications for State LSA, Local LSA, and PennDOT Multimodal for materials purchase.
4. MS4 Stream Restoration – Logpile Run / Weirich Avenue
 - HCEG has prepared base mapping and is coordinating a meeting with the land owner to discussion the project
 - HCEG has met with property owner and is awaiting final requirements from them for the Easement Exhibit.
5. MS4 Permit
 - HCEG is evaluating multiple storm sewer system locations
6. The Dales at Canton PRD
 - Land development submission received 7/5/2024
 - HCEG has completed a completeness review and sent findings to the applicant
 - HCEG has drafted technical review letter of the current submission
7. SR 844 Sanitary Sewer I&I Project
 - Met with WEWJA 3/13. WEWJA will install cast in place liner anywhere the Township pays for cleaning and grouting. WEJWA is determining the best location for the work.
 - WEWJA has delayed Basis of Design Meeting until December.
8. Act 537 Wastewater Management Plan
 - Draft flow projections have been shared with WEWJA for their comprehensive plan.
 - HCEG will be submitting updated draft plan to DEP prior to WEWJA meeting.
9. Brickridge Estates Phase IV
 - Preliminary subdivision approval was conditionally approved
 - No further submissions have been received
10. Washington Penn Plastics Grading Permit
 - HCEG has reviewed the application and is coordinated additional information with the applicant.
 - Awaiting execution of the legal agreement
11. West Wylie Park

- Grant Submitted - Broadband Authority's Multipurpose Community Facilities Grant HCEG prepared design plans and estimates for the Rec Center Project

12. GIS Services

- HCEG is currently maintaining several GIS maps for the Township.

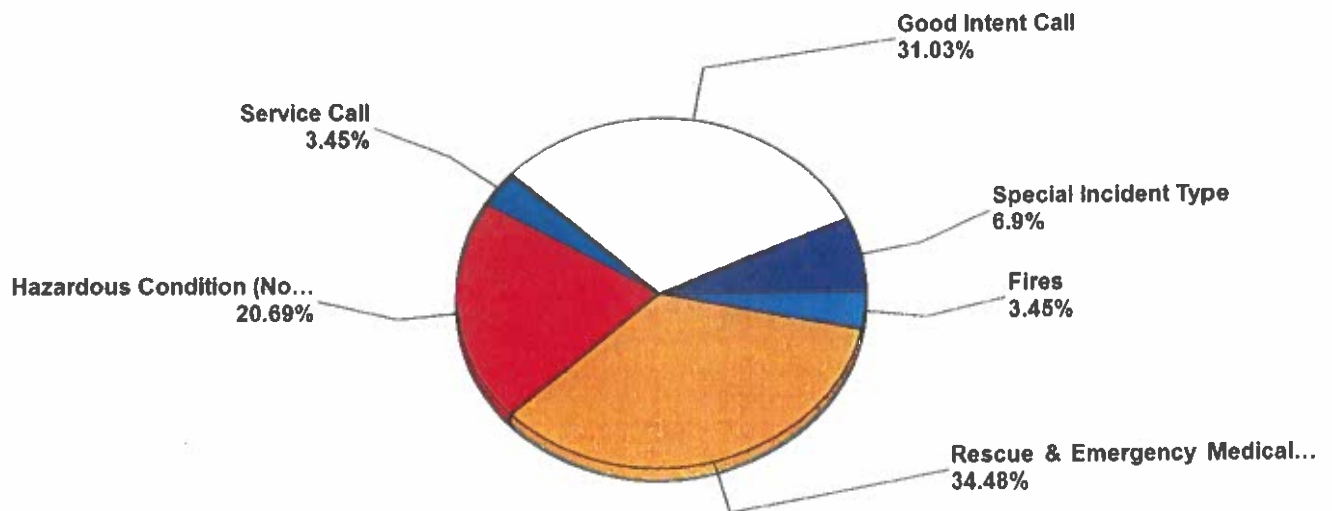

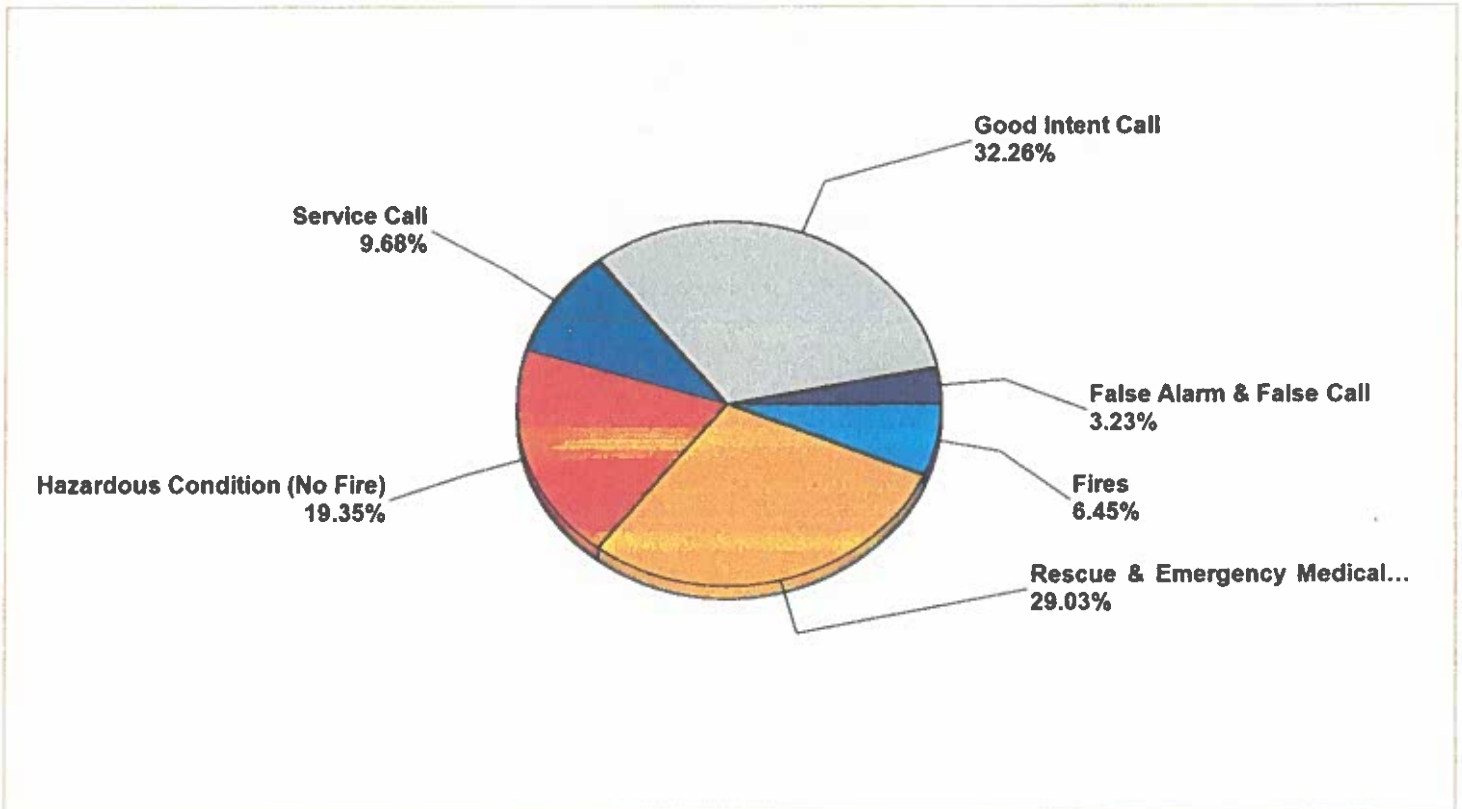
