Active Projects

1. Land Development Reviews
 - **The Dales at Canton:**
 - HCEG received a new submission on 4/9 and is in the process of issuing a review letter.
 - **Brick Ridge Estates Phase 4:** preliminary subdivision conditionally approved, awaiting further submissions from the developer.
 - **Running Brook:** under construction. Possible consolidation plan coming
2. West Wylie Park
 - HCEG is preparing grant submittal for DCED for Phase 1 Park Improvements.
 - HCEG will conduct site investigations and design trail routes over the spring/summer for possible construction in the fall.
3. MS4 Stream Restoration – Logpile Run / Weirich Avenue
 - **Drone survey completed. Wetland delineation to be scheduled**
4. Stormwater Study
 - **HCEG is preparing preliminary design options.**
5. MS4 Permit
 - **Need to schedule annual MS4 training.**
6. Rex Road Slide
 - **Wall option would be very costly. HCEG will prepare alternate design plans.**
7. Lacock Street Hazardous Walking Traffic Study:
 - **Completed**
8. Miller Road Improvements Project
 - HCEG is preparing GP-7 Permit for replacing the culverts
 - HCEG prepared grant applications for State LSA, Local LSA, and PennDOT Multimodal for materials purchase. **Awaiting funding decision.**
9. Act 537 Wastewater Management Plan
 - Draft flow projections have been shared with WEWJA for their comprehensive plan.
 - WEWJA intends to submit the regional Act 537 Plan in May 2024
10. GIS Services
 - HCEG is currently maintaining several GIS maps for the Township.

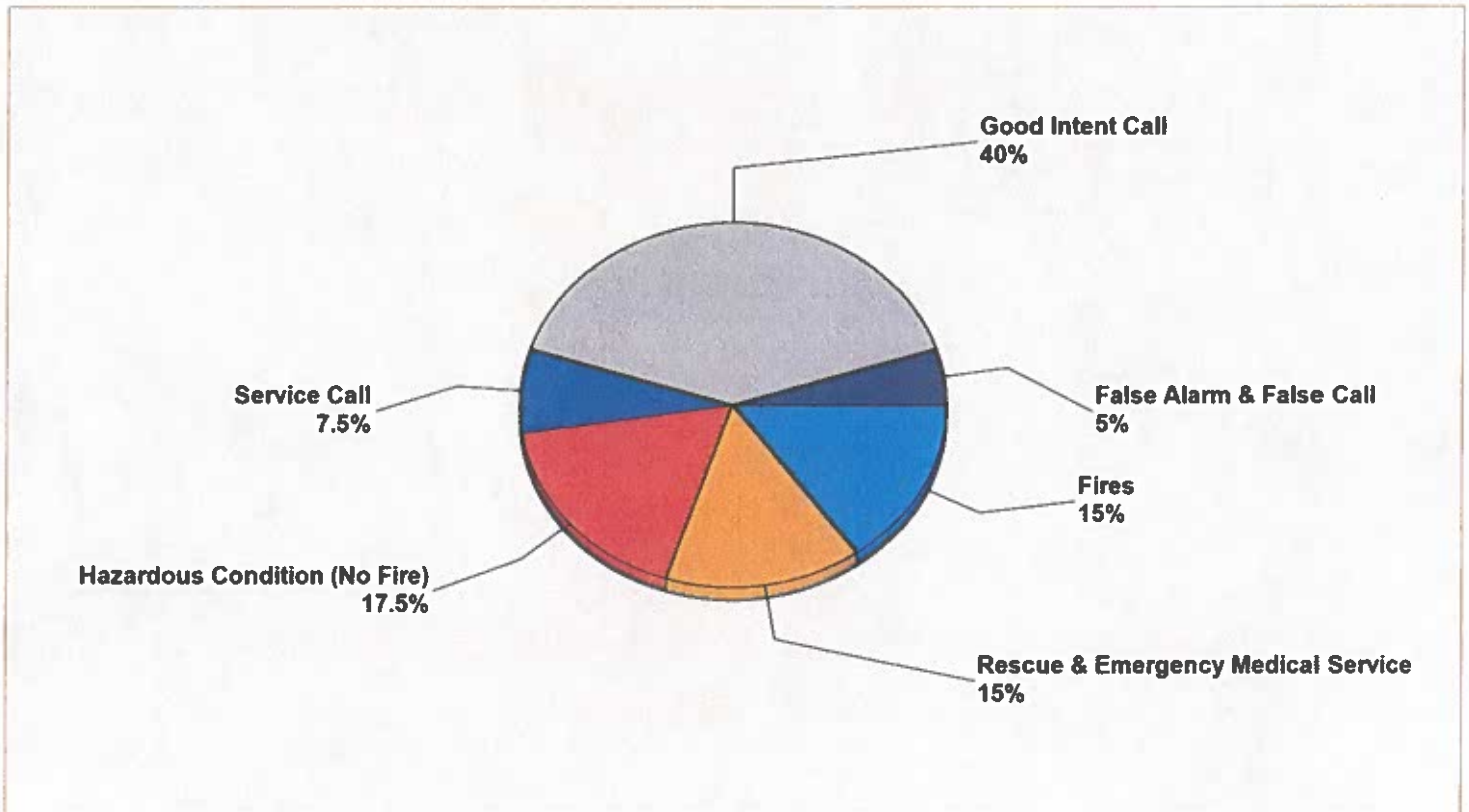
