

Township Engineer's Report June 12th, 2025

Active Projects

1. Land Development Reviews
 - **The Dales at Canton:**
 - Conditionally Approved as of April 2025 meeting
 - **Brick Ridge Estates Phase 4:** preliminary subdivision conditionally approved, awaiting further submissions from the developer.
2. West Wylie Park
 - HCEG has submitted a grant submittal for DCED to secure funding for clearing and grubbing, pad construction, electric service extension, lamppost installation, a small pavilion, and materials purchase for the gravel and blacktop for the driveway and parking lot
 - HCEG has begun preliminary trail layout at the park, portions are too thick to layout without some heavy brush cutting. There's still significant ATV trespassing from neighboring properties.
3. MS4 Stream Restoration – Logpile Run / Weirich Avenue
 - Drone survey completed.
 - Markosky has completed wetland delineation work.
4. MS4 Permit
 - Annual MS4 Training today
5. Stormwater Study
 - HCEG has prepared preliminary designs and an approximate easement area.
6. Rex Road Slide
 - HCEG has prepared preliminary designs and an approximate ROW/Easement requirements. Assuming a 33' existing ROW, to complete the project the Township needs 20' of additional permanent ROW (total under 1 acre) and 50' outside the existing ROW for a slope easement.
7. Miller Road Improvements Project
 - HCEG is preparing GP-7 Permit for replacing the culverts
 - HCEG prepared grant applications for State LSA, Local LSA, and PennDOT Multimodal for materials purchase. Awaiting funding decision.
8. Act 537 Wastewater Management Plan
 - Draft flow projections have been shared with WEWJA for their comprehensive plan.
 - WEWJA intends to submit the regional Act 537 Plan in July 2025
9. GIS Services
 - HCEG is currently maintaining several GIS maps for the Township.
