

Township Engineer's Report February 12th, 2026

Active Projects

1. Land Development Reviews

- **Brick Ridge Estates Phase 4: HCEG has attended a preapplication meeting with the Township and new applicant and answered some initial questions from the developer.**
- **Stewart Well Pad: HCEG has reviewed the resubmission of the grading permit application and supporting info and has recommended approval.**
- **The Dales at Canton: Conditionally Approved as of April 2025 meeting. At the Township's discretion, Harshman is available for inspections to ensure the construction is meeting the expectations of the Township's ordinances & expectations.**

2. Rex Road Slide

- **Bids received we recommend awarding the project to Slusarczyk Excavating for the bid amount of \$190,000.00.**
- **Road reconstruction is mostly complete and road is reopened. Some minor work will continue to take place, final paving will be completed in spring.**
- **Pay application has been submitted for the fencing work, we've reviewed and approve the amount.**

3. Miller Road Improvements Project

- **Township Awarded \$165,050 from PennDOT Multimodal Grant**
- **Township Awarded \$165,000 from State LSA Grant**
- **GP-7 Permit is approved**
- **Recommending Township authorize purchase of pipes so they can be ordered as soon as possible.**

4. MS4 Permit

- **Continue annual requirements.**
- **Dry weather screening should resume for new permit cycle.**
- **We've prepare a flyer to go out with the Tax bills to meet education requirements**

5. West Wylie Park

- **HCEG has began preliminary trail layout at the park, portions are too thick to layout without some heavy brush cutting. We're anticipating reviewing the loop with the road crew when the snow melts.**
- **America250 Grant Awarded in the amount of \$25,000.00. Money has to be spent by July 31st 2026**
