Township Engineer's Report
May 9, 2019

Active Projects:

1. Airport Road Bridge – Bridge design is complete. DEP comments addressed and ready to submit. Waiting on the Authorization to Enter agreement to complete the comment response.
2. MS4 – Creating a List of Outfalls that will require Access Agreements for testing. Review the option of amending the Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP) to utilize new mapping techniques to reduce the regulatory burden. This could save the Township on future construction cost.
3. New Township Rec Center – Architectural plans 80% complete, ready to add in the mechanical systems. Coordinating utility location with facility owners. Meet with WEWJA and found the proposed tap in location. Land swap area delineated on site and ready for Township / Union review. Land swap will need resolved before finalizing the utility Rec Center's utility services.
4. Lacock Street – Plans completed, Finalizing legal descriptions for roadway and two (2) new storm sewer easements.
5. Fettis Subdivision – Sewage Planning documents complete. Will be submitting to sewage council for review and signature.
6. Jackson Property – Review complete and ready for Township signature.
7. WEWJA II – Project may have some extra funds. Tom Murphy would like to meet and review doing similar scope in another section.
