Active Projects:

1. MS4
 - a. Working on Annual Report for DEP.
2. New Township Rec Center.
 - a. Coordinating utility location with facility owners. Need to finalize access easements once the Township / Steel Union acquisition is finalized
3. 844 I&I – Ongoing. Researching route and cost for lift station.
4. Sheffield Street – Storm Sewer Improvement Design Complete. Made 2nd Phone call to Rob, at PennDOT with no response. Coordination with Gas and Water Utility Companies required during construction of new system.
5. Shady Lane – Meet with PennDOT. Completed Sight Distance analysis for intersection. PennDOT needs to relocate construction sign and trim trees in ROW.

Inactive Projects:

6. Airport Road Bridge – Bridge design is complete with DEP approval
7. Fettis Subdivision – Sewage Planning documents complete and submitted to sewage council. Landowner will need to schedule an inspection with the Sewage Enforcement Officer.
