

**Active Projects:**

1. **MS4** - Renewal submitted
  - a. Need a copy of the street sweeping logs for records.
2. **Sheffield Street** - PennDOT has inlet boxes in yard ready for pick up / Delivery. Grates are on backorder.
3. **Bridge Inspection**
  - a. Mulberry
    - i. Lane restriction plan submitted, and bridge reduced to a single lane
    - ii. Starting the design to repair/ reinforce the bridge structure
  - b. Berthel
    - i. Working on the repair to the abutment. Work will need completed by February for compliance.
4. **Brockway Glass** –
  - a. Demolition in progress. Structure is down. Contractor working on foundations and clearing demolition piles.
  - b. Reviewed revised Stormwater Management Plan submitted by PVE. Will be sending out comments shortly.
5. **MJ Patterson Subdivision** – reviewed application and issued comment letter
6. **Mulberry Hill Grading Permit** – Reviewed application and issued comment letter

**Inactive Projects:**

7. **Airport Road Bridge** – Bridge design is complete with DEP approval
8. **Fettis Subdivision** – Sewage Planning documents complete and submitted to sewage council. Landowner will need to schedule an inspection with the Sewage Enforcement Officer.
9. **New Township Rec Center.**
  - a. Coordinating utility location with facility owners. Need to finalize access easements once the Township / Steel Union acquisition is finalized
