**Township Engineer's Report**  
**October 8, 2020**

**Active Projects:**

1. Berthel Bridge – The contractor returned on October 2, 2020 to spot grouted voids behind the grout bag. The area is ready for Township to install Rip-Rap.
2. Mulberry Bridge – Plans and Specifications were sent to PennDOT for their structural adequacy review. PennDOT anticipates having review completed by middle of October.
3. Airport Bridge – Plans and Specifications were sent to PennDOT for their structural adequacy review. PennDOT anticipates having review completed by middle of October.
4. McClay Bridge – Structural Engineer has completed the preliminary design and are currently working on detailing the design and finalizing their set of Contract Documents.
5. 844 I&I – Drnach Environmental is preparing flow meters and are scheduled to install meters beginning of November.
6. Jefferson Ave Park – Drafted a site layout plan for new pavilion and coordinated layout with the pavilion manufacturer. Additionally, we are coordinating with water and electric utility providers to extend service to new pavilion.
7. Running Brook – We have completed a site visit, and meeting with the contractor to review the installation of the temporary access road. Developer has secured the necessary permits from PennDOT to access site from Hickory Street.
8. Brooks Subdivision – Completed initial review of submitted subdivision and issued comment letter. We are awaiting resubmission of plans following a Zoning Hearing Board review.

1. Price Property – Completed cost estimate for repairs.
