**Active Projects:**

1. Berthel Bridge – Repairs completed.
2. Mulberry Bridge – PennDOT responded with a few comments. Our Structural Engineer has reviewed and is addressing the comments.
3. Airport Bridge – PennDOT responded with a few comments. Our Structural Engineer has reviewed and is addressing the comments.
4. McClay Bridge – Structural Design nearing completion and we expect having contract documents ready by the end of November.
5. 844 I&I – Flow monitors were installed last week in October and are currently collecting data.
6. Jefferson Ave Park – We continued coordinating with water and electric company for services to new pavilion. Also, worked with the road department on locating foundations for the playground.
7. Hickory Street Turnover – We meet with PennDOT on site to review the process of defining scope if Township is interested taking over the road.
8. Traffic Calming 844/Midland - We drafted an initial cost estimate for installing warning lights at intersection.
