Active Projects:

1. McClay Bridge – Contract Executed and Notice to proceed was issued to Gary Metzinger. Reviewed contractors' submittals and demolition in progress.
2. Mulberry Bridge – Submitted permitting to DEP and starting to prepare project specifications.
3. Airport Bridge – Need approval for Gannett Fleming to conduct a Weight Limit study to satisfy PennDOT Bridge Inspection.
4. Park Pavilion – Received bonds and insurance from contractor and drafted contract for execution.
5. Murphy Drive Storm – Completed site survey and associated easement plans.
6. Sewer Master Plan – Working on computing cost analysis for sewer treatment plan and pump station options.
7. 353 West Wylie Stormwater – Review stormwater complaint submitted by landowner and found the current stormwater controls were functional. Issued report and video site under rain event.
8. 198 Malone Ridge – Review stormwater complaint submitted by landowner. Observations was limited to the public Right-of-way and further review will be required.
9. MS4 – Preparing documentation for the annual report.
