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Township Engineer's Report
November 11, 2021

Active Projects:

1. **McClay Bridge** – Construction is in progress. The old bridge deck demolition was completed. The new foundation poured, new beams installed, and contractor was working on installing the reinforcement. The concrete pour is scheduled for this afternoon. (Attached progress photos)
 - a. The contractor has submitted pay application #1 for \$49,702.23 and would recommend payment.
2. **Mulberry Bridge** – received response back from DEP. We will respond to the comments on the wetlands.
3. **Park Pavilion** – Contractor has the Sanitary line installed and currently making the tap into the existing manhole. Waterline installation in progress and Electrician should be on site by end of the week to begin the electrical service. (Attached progress photos)
 - a. The contractor has submitted pay application #1 for \$31,149.48 and would recommend payment.
4. **Sewer Master Plan** – We received a mail from KLH, engineer for WEWJA requesting flow rates for any proposed development areas. We will send over the data we have prepared for the 844 corridors.
