April 12, 2022

Active Projects:

1. Mulberry Bridge – Awaiting final comments from Washington County Conservation District. Finalized bid documents and sent a copy over to Chartiers Twp for their review.
2. Jefferson Ave. Park –
 - a. Meet with contractor on leaking waterline and trench settlement. Contract to return at the end of April to address the settlement.
 - b. Working with Pavilion Manufacturer on water hammer issue.
3. 664 Buena Vista – Reviewed condition of existing structures for dangerous buildings and issued report recommending demolition of structures.
4. Sewer Expansion - Spoke with WEWJA and interceptor will need upgrades before additional tap are issued.
