## Township Engineer's Report September 8, 2022

### Active Projects:

1. WEWJA capacity issues
  - Workshop held at WEWJA on 8/9/22. WEWJA requested an updated 537 Plan
  - Task Activity Report has been prepared and needs to be signed by the Township Secretary prior to submission to DEP.
  - Copies of previous plans have been obtained. Updated plan preparation has begun. Target submittal to DEP March 2023.
2. McClay Rd Bridge for Helipad
  - Fieldwork and Permit Application has been prepared and will be submitted to WCCD with signatures from Township.
3. Mulberry Bridge
  - Bid Awarded to J Stewart for \$210,000.
  - Demolition of deck is complete, and riprap installed at abutments. Cracked concrete and spalling repairs have begun.
  - Bridge delivery is not expected until October and will depend on manufacturer's schedule. Install time expected to take 2-weeks after delivery.
4. Running Brooke
  - Developers Agreement approved.
  - Building Permit approved and awaiting payment & pick-up by Permittee.
  - Nothing new from DEP regarding abandoned gas well in cul-de-sac.
5. MS4 Stream Restoration
  - Chevron land permissions pending (not EQT owned as previously understood). We're setting up a call/meeting with Mr. Bazant.
  - Quarterly Reports have been prepared and are being submitted to DEP.
6. MS4 GIS Mapping
  - Nearing completion. Draft is finalized and being reviewed internally to add forest buffers and info from Township screening.
7. Hickory Street turnback
  - HCEG coordinating the preparation of construction documents. Will not be able to construct until Spring 2023 due to paving season.
