Active Projects:

1. WEWJA capacity issues
 - Workshop held at WEWJA on 8/9/22. WEWJA requested an updated 537 Plan
 - **Task Activity Report has been approved by DEP.**
 - Copies of previous plans have been obtained. Updated plan preparation has begun. Target submittal to DEP March 2023.
2. McClay Rd Bridge for Helipad
 - 10/7/22 Harshman responded to first round of comments from WCCD
3. Mulberry Bridge
 - Bid Awarded to J Stewart for \$210,000.
 - Demolition of deck is complete, and riprap installed at abutments. Cracked concrete and spalling repairs have begun.
 - **Due to structural defects of the abutments, MR Structures has been consulted and is coordinating repairs with J Stewart.**
 - **MR. Structures is reviewing the shop drawings for the bridge. Bridge delivery is delayed from initial schedule. Install time expected to take 2-weeks after delivery.**
4. Running Brooke
 - Developers Agreement approved.
 - Building Permit approved and awaiting payment & pick-up by Permittee.
 - **Operations have begun on cul-de-sac gas well.**
5. Hixenbaugh Subdivision
 - Has been reviewed and is recommended for approval.
6. MS4 Permit
 - Annual report was prepared and submitted to DEP.
7. MS4 Stream Restoration
 - Chevron land permissions pending (not EQT owned as previously understood). We're setting up a call/meeting with Mr. Bazant.
 - Quarterly Reports have been prepared and are being submitted to DEP.
8. Hickory Street turnback
 - HCEG coordinating the preparation of construction documents. Will not be able to construct until Spring 2023 due to paving season.


