Township Engineer's Report January 12th, 2023

Active Projects:

1. MS4 Permit
 - **MS4 PRP Public comment period is open until January 31st.**
 - New requirement is down to 1800' of stream restoration with no inlet filters.
 - We reduced the required pounds of sediment reduction from 204,152 lbs., 78,815 lbs. a 61% reduction in regulatory burden.
 - Based on recent bids for stream restoration projects this 61% reduction could mean a savings for the Township of \$500,000-\$1,500,000
2. WEWJA capacity issues
 - Workshop held at WEWJA on 8/9/22. WEWJA requested an updated 537 Plan
 - Task Activity Report has been approved by DEP.
 - Copies of previous plans have been obtained. Updated plan preparation has begun. Target submittal to DEP March 2023.
 - **Harshman met with WEWJA on 11/17 regarding potential development and existing limitations.**
3. White Street Grading Permit
 - **Application was reviewed and comments forwarded to applicant's engineer.**
4. Mulberry Bridge
 - **Bridge has been installed and pay application #2 is recommended for payment.**
5. Running Brooke
 - Developers Agreement approved.
 - Building Permit approved and awaiting payment & pick-up by Permittee.
 - Operations have begun on cul-de-sac gas well.
6. MS4 Stream Restoration
 - Chevron land permissions pending (not EQT owned as previously understood). We're setting up a call/meeting with Mr. Bazant.
 - Quarterly Reports have been prepared and are being submitted to DEP.
7. Hickory Street turnback
 - HCEG coordinating the preparation of construction documents. Will not be able to construct until Spring 2023 due to paving season.
