

**Township Engineer's Report**  
**February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

**Active Projects:**

1. **Act 537 Wastewater Management Plan**
  - **Plan preparation underway.**
  - **Township is surveying property owners to identify existing issues.**
2. **MS4 Permit**
  - **PRP Plan Public comment period has closed, no comments were received.**
  - **We are preparing final PRP Plan for submittal to DEP.**
  - **New requirement is down to 1800' of stream restoration with no inlet filters.**
  - **We reduced the required pounds of sediment reduction from 204,152 lbs., 78,815 lbs. a 61% reduction in regulatory burden.**
  - **Based on recent bids for stream restoration projects this 61% reduction could mean a savings for the Township of \$500,000-\$1,500,000**
3. **White Street Grading Permit**
  - **2<sup>nd</sup> submittal was reviewed and all comments were addressed. We recommended that grading permit be issued.**
4. **MS4 Stream Restoration – Logpile Run / Weirich Avenue**
  - **On hold for Legal Agreement with Mr. Byzant.**
  - **1 year extension granted on DEP Growing Greener Grant.**
5. **Hickory Street turnback**
  - **HCEG has prepared construction plans and bid specifications and will submit to PennDOT after field review with the Township Roadmaster.**
6. **Running Brooke**
  - **Developers Agreement approved.**
  - **Building Permit approved and awaiting payment & pick-up by Permittee.**
  - **Operations have begun on cul-de-sac gas well.**
