Township Engineer's Report August 10th, 2023

Active Projects:

1. Hickory Street turnback
 - Project has been awarded to Morgan Excavating. HCEG is currently waiting on final contract paperwork and schedule from Morgan.
 - **HCEG has been coordinating with utility companies to design the stormsewer system in a way that works with the utilities.**

2. Act 537 Wastewater Management Plan
 - We've been assisting with short-term solutions for the Dales Development.
 - **We're planning to have estimate flow requirements by the end of August. We received updated mapping from WEWJA at the beginning of August that required the previous calculations be rechecked.**

3. Subdivision Reviews
 - **We have reviewed and recommended conditional approval for two subdivisions in the past month.**

4. SR 844 Sanitary Sewer I&I Project
 - HCEG has begun preparing documents for the next phase of grouting the 844 interceptor.

5. MS4 Permit
 - Updated & Advertised PRP Plan has been submitted to DEP. No comments have been received yet.
 - 5 Year Renewal has been submitted and received by DEP. DEP stated their technical review may take up to 12 months.
 - **Annual reports are due September 31st. We will be preparing and submitting the annual report.**

6. MS4 Stream Restoration – Logpile Run / Weirich Avenue
 - On hold for Legal Agreement with Mr. Byzant.
 - 1 year extension granted on DEP Growing Greener Grant.

7. West Wylie Park
 - Harshman prepared and submitted a grant to DCED's GTRP grant for Phase 1 Park Development. Decision expected in fall 2023.

8. Running Brooke
 - Building Permit approved and awaiting payment & pick-up by Permittee.

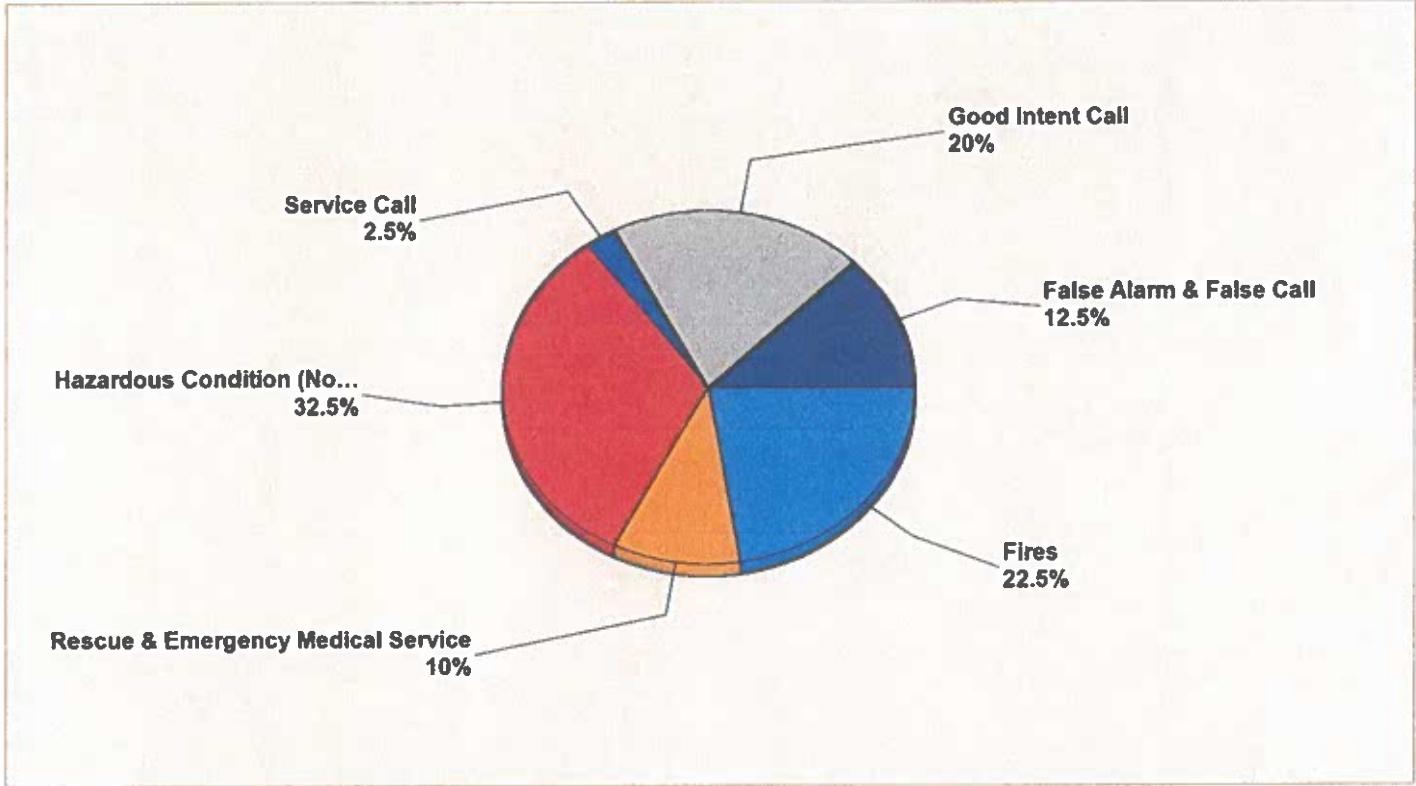
